Above: Pouline was confirmed in Vor Frelser (Our Savior) Church and the family could see the church from their windows

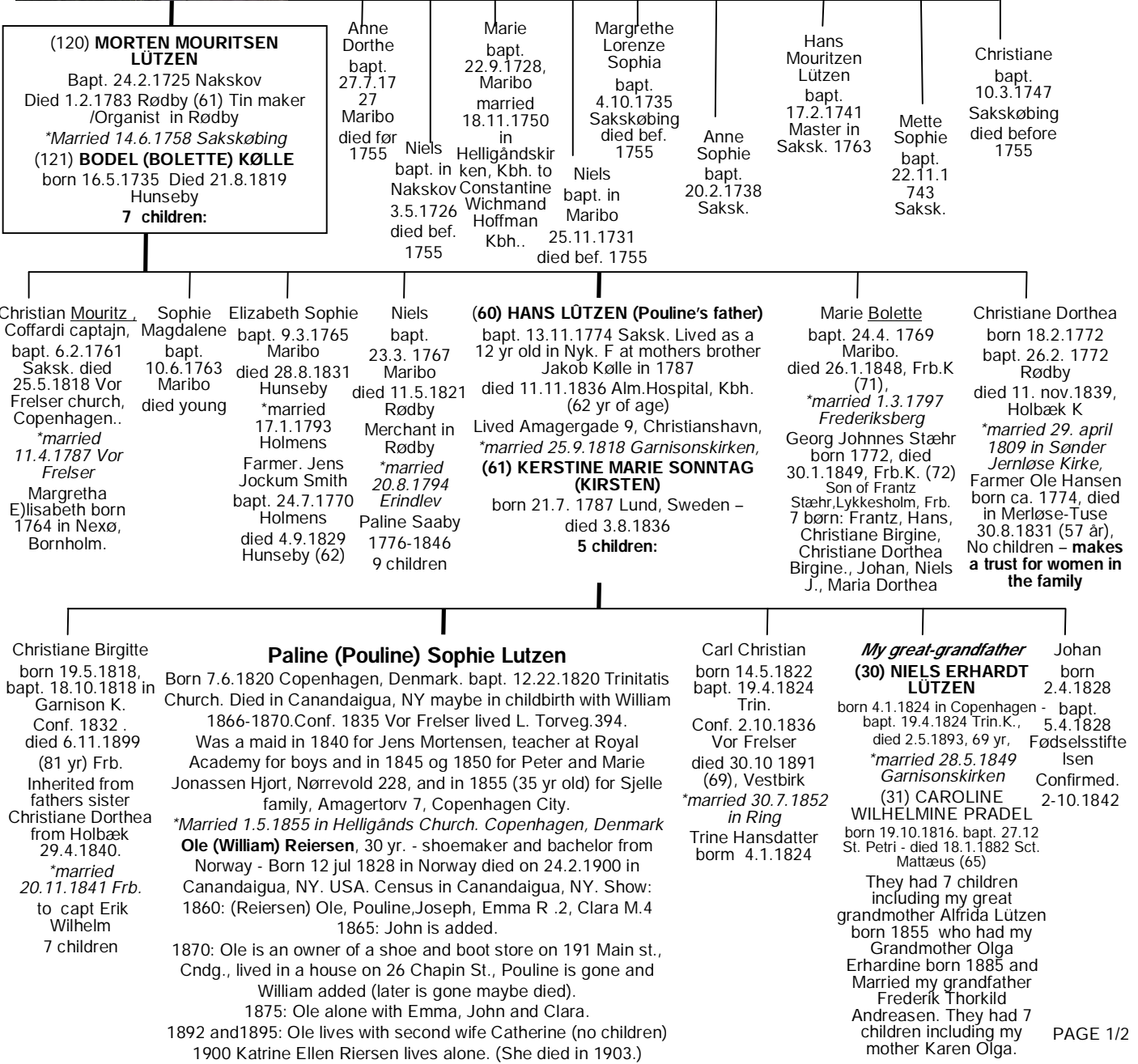

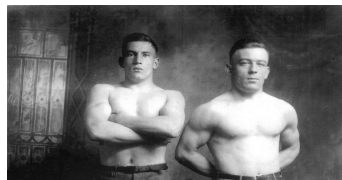

Buena Vista (Buny) Turnbow

Born 25. May 1874 in Johnson, Ill, and Died 9. March
1980 in Paradise, Butte, Ca. age 106. She was a
daughter of Isaac Presley Turnbow, b. April 6, 1827 in
Birmingham, AL and he died May 23, 1885 in
Palouse, WA and was married to Elizabeth Ann Wells
Jones b. Jan. 29, 1830 in NC. They had 10 children
